Symptoms of attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) include difficulty concentrating, disorganization, distractibility, forgetting and trouble completing tasks on time.

The treatment can be added to other treatment (such as medication) the child is receiving. Prior diagnosis is not necessary.

Qualified participants receive free evaluation and treatment, and some reimbursement for time and travel. Risks will be explained before agreeing to participate.
